BE AN ALLY

DESCRIPTION: Two young people are on a video chat. You, the audience, are treated as a third character on that chat. When the chat gets a little uncomfortable, how might you respond if you were actually there?

GRADE LEVEL FOCUS: Grades 2-5

SEL FOCUS: Standard 4: Interpersonal Communication - NHES.4.5.3 Demonstrate nonviolent strategies to manage or resolve conflict.

ACTIVITY: After witnessing the video-chat of two friends, students discuss how they might have reacted if they had actually been in on the chat.
