DESCRIPTION: Teaching artist Ms. Lily guides students to creatively portray important aspects of themselves that the teacher might not know.

ACTIVITY: Create frozen statues with the body

TO PREPARE:

- Preview the video before sharing it with your students to best help you introduce the activity.
- Let students know they will be encouraged to create frozen statues with their bodies. They can create the statues either sitting or standing, whatever makes them comfortable to participate.
- Feel free to pause the video and repeat any segments. Encourage them to be honest and bold with their choices and to enjoy. The more they join in, the more they will get out of the creative experience!
