DESCRIPTION: "It's not my fault!" What causes partners to blame each other for their problems working together? HTY teaching artists Ms. Lily and Mr. Jonathan are joined by guest artist Ms. Stephanie to present a scene of students who struggle to work well together, asking the question: How might the characters of Maka and Nina improve their working relationship?

ACTIVITY: Watch a scene of two students who are having trouble working well together. Afterwards, discuss (and maybe even act out) what choices the two students could have made to improve their working relationship.
